During the month of November, our Kindergarteners learned what being thankful meant. They came up with their own reason for being thankful. They drew a picture and wrote about what it meant to them.

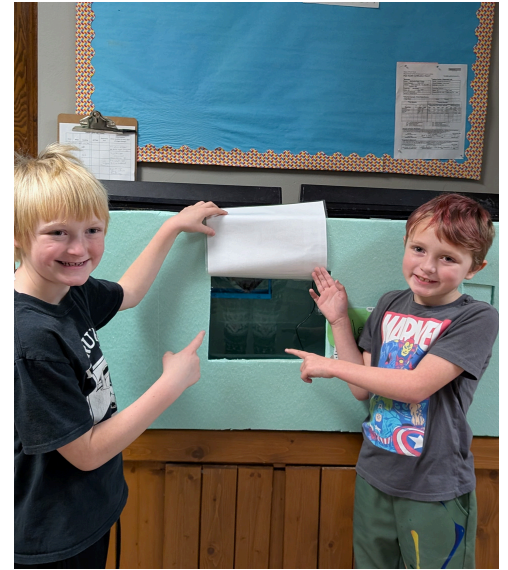
